

## Miss CRRA Queen & Royalty Contestant Rules

These rules are to be followed by each queen or royalty contestant while competing during the CRRA Finals. Disqualification may occur if these rules are not followed. Any decision made by the acting director and judges are final and will not be appealed or contested.

1. There will be no alcohol, smoking or drugs of any kind permitted at any time. If you violate this rule you will be disqualified. This behavior will not be tolerated.
2. Each contestant is required to have a sponsor and must pay a \$75 entry fee.
3. Each contestant is required to sign a release upon arrival and before competition.
4. Dress code will be enforced at all times. This means rodeo attire, button up shirt, slinkies, jeans, boots, hat. Please save the shorts, tank tops, flip flops etc. for your hotel room only. We will have activities planned where you will be allowed to dress in casual clothes. You may wear casual clothes when you arrive Wed., Oct.15<sup>th</sup> .
5. Each Contestant will be required to sell at least \$500 worth of raffle tickets – (\$750. for Queen contestants) in order to compete. If raffle tickets are not sold contestant will be disqualified.
6. All contestants will be responsible for all tickets and ticket money; no additional tickets will be handed out until previously sold ones are turned in. This money is to be used to purchase prizes for contestants, so the more tickets you sell the sooner we can get those prizes purchased. Any lost or stolen tickets must be paid for, so be sure you keep up with them.
7. Back Tags are to be worn during every activity. This includes Radio Station & Sponsor appearances, Speech, Modeling, Interview, Horsemanship, and nightly rodeos.
8. No males are allowed in the hotel rooms of contestants.
9. The new Miss CRRA Queen will be required to stay and participate in the award ceremonies at the end of the finals.
10. Contestants must attend all scheduled events. In the event of an illness or emergency you must contact the queen director and inform her immediately.

11. The winners in each category will sign a contract stating that they will fulfill their obligations to appear at CRRA rodeos and sponsored events throughout the year. It will be mandatory for the Queen to attend the 2009 finals in order to crown a new queen.
12. Each title winner will be required to dress in queen attire, wearing jeans, shirt, hat, boots, crown and sash upon signing in to represent at all rodeos or sponsored events. A queen or princess contestant will be required to stay in queen attire throughout each rodeo performance at the finals. No going to the trailer and changing into street clothes to sit in the stands. This is also true if you are a title winner. You will be a representative of CRRA and will dress appropriately. Winners must have appearance sheets signed at all events and mail them to the queen director during the year.
13. Each title winner will be required to attend a set amount of rodeos and appearances as required by the acting director. You may choose which CRRA rodeos you would like to attend.
14. Each title winner will travel at their own expense, unless arrangements have been made with individual rodeo committees. This is your responsibility.
