

## CRRA Royalty Regulations 2008

1. Contestants must have a sponsor and a \$75 entry fee must be paid. Last day to enter this competition will be August 15, 2008. All Entry forms and fees must be turned in to the Coordinator by this date.
2. Queen Contestant must be between the ages of 16 - 24 as of Oct. 1, 2008. Princess contestant must be between the ages of 10-14 as of Oct. 1, 2008. Little Miss must be between the ages of 3-9 as of Oct. 1, 2008.
3. Each contestant will be required to sign a release upon entering this competition.
4. Each contestant will be required to check in at hotel by October 15, 2008. Final hotel information will be given as soon as possible.
5. Each contestant will be responsible for their own transportation to and from arena.
6. All contestants will be responsible for their own meals during finals week. 1 meal will be provided during the luncheon on Thursday, October 16, 2008, and 1 free ticket for the guest of each contestant will be given. All friends and family are invited to the luncheon but must pay for their own meal.
7. Contestants must never have been married or had a child or be pregnant.
8. Contestant must submit a recent 5x7 Glossy portrait to be displayed in sponsor window. This photo will also be judged for the photogenic category of this competition.
9. All Jr. Queen and Little Miss contestants will be required to sell \$500 worth of raffle tickets in order to compete in this competition. All ticket money and unsold tickets must be turned in by October 15, 2008. If the \$500 minimum tickets are not sold, contestants will not be able to compete. No exceptions. Each raffle ticket will cost \$1 each and will be for a drawing of \$500 total cash. There will be 3 drawings on Saturday, October 18, 2008: 1 for \$250 , 1 for \$150 and 1 for \$100 cash. If contestants sell more than \$750 worth of raffle tickets they will have 5 additional points added to their total score as bonus points. No more than 5 additional points will be added per contestant. This does not include Little Miss contestants. The Little Miss CRRA title winner will be based on total number of raffle tickets sold. Miss CRRA (Queen) will be required to sell \$750. worth of raffle tickets and if they sell \$1000. worth of tickets they will get the extra points added to their score.

10. Contestants will be required to make a radio station and sponsor visit accompanied by queen coordinator during finals week.
11. No stud horses will be allowed for horsemanship competition.
12. In case of a tie the contestant with the highest personality score will be the winner.
13. Contestants must respect the decisions of the judges. The decisions are final and may not be contested or appealed.
14. Any questions and information concerning any part of the CRRA Royalty competition is to be addressed to the queen coordinator only. If you have concerns be sure to ask questions.
15. Current Coggins papers must be shown on any horse that is to be used for the CRRA finals.
